

## Junior Counselor (JuCo) Program Waiver 2024

Junior Counselors at Camp Woodmont are 16-18 year old junior staff volunteers who have proven to have positive personality and character qualities. These character traits include a fun personality, excellent leadership skills, high morals, emotional maturity, physical stamina, Christian values, dependability, patience, fairness, enthusiasm, sincere love and respect of children, and a well groomed appearance. Junior Counselors must understand that their primary responsibility is to serve the needs of the camp and be role models for the campers. Junior Counselors that do not meet camp standards and/or not following camp policies will be asked to leave the program immediately.

Junior Counselors will be involved in learning situations by assisting counselors in the cabins and with the program activities. They will be assigned to cabins according to the needs of the camp and will be living in cabins with and assisting with younger campers. They will also be expected to assist in the kitchen before and after meals for food prep and clean up and with camp maintenance on a rotating schedule. They will have fun, but Junior Counselors must understand that their primary focus must be on the needs of the campers and camp program. Junior Counselors receive many intrinsic rewards from interacting with campers/staff and contributing to team-oriented camp operations.

FEES: Our Junior Counselor Program is a volunteer based program and since they are now considered Junior Staff Members, they will no longer have to pay camp tuition. Junior Counselors can earn volunteer hours for school or they may accept our small thank you at the end of the week. The small thank you stipend works as follows: First Year JuCo: \$75/week , Second Year JuCo: \$100/week , Third Year JuCo: \$125/week

Upon completion of the application, Junior Counselors will be selected for a specific one or two-week session on a first-come, first-serve basis, plus an evaluation by management which may include interviews and reference checks.
